



TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1990

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (GENERAL DEVELOPMENT PROCEDURE) ORDER 1995

REGULATION 3 OF THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1992

To:- East Sussex County Council c/o Clare Jones Education Office Tower Building Lower South Road St Leonards on Sea

County Ref. No. HS/2284/CC Borough Ref. No. HS/CC/04/239

In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Act, Order and Regulations, the Council as the local planning authority hereby GRANT PLANNING PERMISSION for construction of all weather games surface with surrounding 2.75m fencing for school and community use. Little Ridge C P School, Little Ridge Avenue, St Leonards on Sea (within land edged red on applicants plan no. 1) in accordance with your application received by the Director of Transport and Environment of East Sussex County Council on 10 March 2004 and the plans and particulars submitted in connection therewith and listed below, and subject also to due compliance with the condition(s) specified hereunder:-

1. The development permitted shall be begun before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

Development shall not commence until details of the construction access, hours of work, times and routes for the movement of construction traffic, which shall avoid conflict with the school use and a scheme for the restoration of land affected by the works have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Director of Transport and Environment. The details and scheme thereby approved shall be implemented in full and in accordance with the approved timetables.

Reason: To ensure the satisfactory control of the development and to comply with Policy S1 of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011

3. Development shall not commence until a detailed drawing to a scale of 1:250 of the land on which the materials excavated in the course of the carrying out

the development will be deposited as indicated on drawing number 03-014/D/1 has been submitted to and approved in writing by the Director of Transport and Environment. The drawing shall show the following:

- the arrangement of the contours at 1m intervals
- cross sections showing the existing and proposed finished levels of the land with no allowance for any settlement.

Reason: To enable the Local Planning Authority to regulate and control the development in the interests of the amenity of the area and to comply with Policy S1 of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011.

4. Material resulting from excavations associated with the development shall not be deposited on the site other than in the area identified on drawing number 03-014/D/1 and approved in accordance with the details shown on the drawing detailed in condition 3 above.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents and Policy EN1of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011

5. Within two months of the commencement of development a scheme for the seeding and maintenance of the tipping area identified on drawing number 03-014/D/1, including a timetable for the carrying out of the work, shall be submitted to and approved in writing by the Director of Transport and Environment. The approved scheme shall be implemented in full in accordance with the approved timetable.

Reason: To ensure the proper restoration of the site in compliance with policy EN1 of the East Sussex and Brighton and Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011.

The development hereby permitted shall not be used other than between the hours of 08.00 to 20.00 on Monday to Friday inclusive and the hours of 09.00 to 13.00 on Saturdays and at no time on Sundays, Public and Bank Holidays unless the use is by or in association with the school.

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents and to comply with Policy S1 of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011.

7. There shall be no artificial illumination of the site

Reason: In the interests of the amenity of adjoining residents and to comply with Policy S1 of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011.

Notwithstanding the difficulties involved the planning authority would wish to see improvement in the drainage of the remaining playing field to permit full use of the area
