



TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1992

Written Notice Pursuant to Regulation 6 (1) of the 1992 Regulations of development authorised by the Director of Transport and Environment.

TAKE NOTICE that under the powers delegated to me by the County Council meeting held on 18 May 1999 I have authorised the development described in Schedule 1 hereto, pursuant to Regulation 3 of the Town and Country Planning General Regulations 1992, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 hereto.

SCHEDULE 1

HS/2358/CC - Removal of galvanised steel sliding folding access door to kitchen and replacement with aluminium entrance doors and side screen. Isabel Blackman Centre, Winding Street, Hastings (within land edged red on applicants plan no. 330049/005/108 AL/2).

SCHEDULE 2

 The development hereby permitted shall be commenced before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission. Written notification of the date on which development is begun shall be sent to the Director of Transport and Environment within 7 days of that date.

Reason: To comply with Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

The works of construction and demolition shall be undertaken in a manner whereby the amount of construction waste resulting from the development shall be reduced to smallest amount possible and every effort be made to reuse, recycle or compost material arising in accordance with the best practicable environmental option.

Reason: To minimise the amount of construction waste to be removed from site for final disposal in accordance with policy W10 of the East Sussex and Brighton and Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011 and WLP11 of the East Sussex and Brighton and Hove Waste Local Plan: Second Deposit April 2004.

No development shall take place until details of the materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the side screen and the treatment of the black panel above the doors have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Director of Transport and Environment. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details (N1a).

Reason: To provide for the proper integration of the development into the site and to comply with policies EN1 and S1 of the East Sussex and Brighton and Hove Structure Plan 1991-2011, and policy DG1 and C1 of the Hastings Local Plan Adopted 14 April 2004.


