



SCHEDULE 1

1. The development hereby permitted shall be commenced before the expiration of five years from the date of this permission.

Reason: To comply with Section 91 Town and Country Planning Act 1990.

 No development shall take place until samples of the materials to be used in the construction of the external surfaces of the extension and enlarged play area hereby permitted have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Director of Transport and Environment. Development shall be carried out in accordance with the approved details.

Reason: In the interests of the character and appearance of the area and to accord with policies EN1 of the East Sussex and Brighton & Hove Structure Plan 1991 - 2011 and ST3 of the Lewes District Local Plan March 2003.
