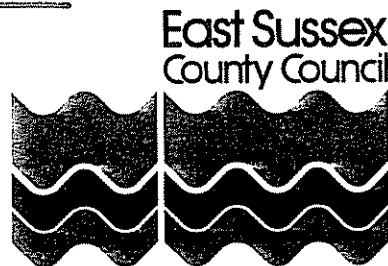

Would you please accept this letter in conjunction with the Plan(s) listed below, as formal notification of the development for the purpose of your Register of Planning Applications and Decisions.

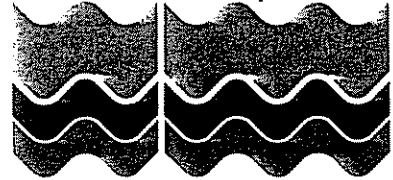

In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Act and Order, the Council as the local planning authority hereby **GRANT PLANNING PERMISSION** for change of use of part of former landfill site to Household Waste Site (to comprise enlargement of existing household waste site area) with retention of office/w.c. and storage facilities; Mountfield Landfill Site in accordance with your application received by the East Sussex County Council on 28 April 1993 and the plans and particulars submitted in connection therewith and subject also to due compliance with the condition(s) specified hereunder:-

1. The development hereby permitted must be begun within the period of five years beginning on the date hereof.
2. No trees on the application site shall be lopped, topped or felled without prior written consent of the County Planning Officer. Any such trees that are removed, become seriously damaged or die shall be replaced in the next planting season with others of similar species.

The reason(s) for the conditions above are :-

1. To comply with Section 91 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990.
2. To preserve the trees on the site in the interests of visual amenity and the environment.
