In pursuance of their powers under the above-mentioned Act and Order, the Council, as the local planning authority, hereby GRANT PLANNING PERMISSION for Extension of drilling operations to 22.00 hours each day (amendment to Permission RR/77/1274). Exploration for minerals including the drilling of boreholes, Brightling Park prospecting area, Dallington and Brightlinge

in accordance with your application received by the Borough/District Council on 19 January 1978. and the plans and particulars submitted in connection therewith and subject also to due compliance with the condition(s) specified hereunder:-

~~XXXXX The development hereby permitted must be begun within the period of five years beginning on the date~~

1. This permission is for a limited period only to expire on 30 September 1978, by which date all buildings, works, plant, machinery and any waste materials and debris shall be removed from the site and the land restored substantially to its former condition to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.
2. Upon completion of use of any borehole, it shall be properly and sufficiently sealed over and any top soil previously removed shall be replaced as the topmost layer and any re-seeding or replanting shall then be carried out to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.
3. Drilling operations shall be carried out between the hours of 08.00 and 22.00 only.
4. No mature trees shall be topped, lopped, felled or wilfully destroyed by the drilling or other operations unless with the prior express consent of the County Planning Authority and any such tree shall be replaced by suitable tree of appropriate species to the satisfaction of the County Planning Authority.

The reasons for the conditions above are:
