RESOLUTION OF THE DIRECTOR OF TRANSPORT AND ENVIRONMENT:

Under the powers delegated to me by the County Council, I resolve to grant planning permission for the proposed development subject to the conditions set out in the recommendation.

CONSIDERATION OF RELEVANT PLANNING MATTERS

1. The site and surroundings

Helenswood Lower School is located in northern Hastings just off of The Ridge (B2093) bordering the High Weald AONB. The school is opposite the Conquest Hospital separated by the main road. There are farms both sides of the school to the east and west and Maplehurst Woods to the north.

2. Proposal

2.1 It is proposed to retain one single and one double prefabricated classroom for five years and retain one single prefabricated classroom for one year.

6. Summary of Policy Issues

- 6.1 The Structure Plan policy S1 seeks to ensure a sustainable future and if development is in a town (S6) then open spaces will be protected from inappropriate development. Policy EN1 states that development should sustain and enhance local character, W10 then goes on to encourage the re-use of existing buildings and recycling.
- 6.2 Hastings Local Plan policy DG1 states that the density, scale and proportions of development should be appropriate to the area and ensures that neighboring properties do not suffer from loss of privacy or increased noise.

7. Considerations

Siting

7.1 The classrooms are situated to the east of the school buildings adjoing a playground area. There are a number of mature trees behind the classrooms which screen the classrooms well from the road, the classrooms are not visible from outside the school grounds.

Design

7.2 The mobile units are standard prefabricated classrooms with grey and green walls with flat grey roofs

Need

7.3 Over recent years the school has taken higher than expected admissions and numbers are expected to continue to rise over the next five years. The single mobile proposed to be kept for 1 year is to provide additional accommodation whilst building works are undertaken for a new sports hall.

8. Conclusion

8.1 The application has been evaluated against the policies of the Structure Plan and Local Plan and for the reasons above the proposal is considered acceptable.

9. Recommendation

- 9.1 Grant planning permission subject to the following conditions:-
 - The single prefabricated building hereby permitted shall be removed and the land restored to a grassed area, on or before 3 September 2003, the remaining two prefabricated classrooms shall be removed on or before 3 September 2007.

Reason: To enable the Local Planning Authority to regulate and control the development of the land.

INFORMATIVE

The applicant is advised that a further planning permission to retain the buildings beyond 3 September 2007 is unlikely to be granted unless a development plan has first been submitted showing how and when the building is proposed to be removed or replaced by permanent accommodation.
