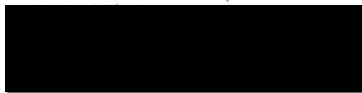
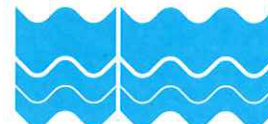

**PLANNING PERMISSION LW/748/CM – REQUEST FOR APPROVAL UNDER
CONDITION 13
NEWHAVEN ENERGY RECOVERY FACILITY (ERF)**

Thank you for your letter dated 8th October, which requests a relaxation to the provisions of Condition 13 of the above permission, to allow up to 25 deliveries of waste on 28th December 2015. I note that your letter provides an explanation and justification for the request.

As you are aware, Condition 13 includes a restriction on the number of household waste deliveries to the ERF on Bank and Public Holidays (excluding street sweepings) to no more than 10 unless with the prior written approval of the Head of Planning and Environment. The reason for the condition is to safeguard the amenity of persons within the locality. Notwithstanding this, the Waste Planning Authority, in drafting the condition, was mindful that there may be occasions when additional deliveries would be required on Bank and Public Holidays, which is why provision is included within the condition to allow for such events.

As noted above, your letter provides an explanation and justification for the request to allow up to 25 waste deliveries on 28th December. This is based on the need to provide certainty that enough waste would be on site to fuel the facility at a time of potential disruption.

In considering your request, I recognise that you are restricting vehicle movements to a minimum in order to meet the required volume of waste for processing. Moreover, I acknowledge that any deliveries will be undertaken while seeking to safeguard the amenity of persons within the locality.

In balancing the above considerations, I hereby **authorise** under Condition 13 of planning permission LW/748/CM that on 28 December 2015 there shall be no more than 25 deliveries of household waste (excluding street sweepings) between the hours of 0800 and 1700. The position regarding the impact of the additional movements will be monitored for future consideration.
