**Description:** The construction and use of plant, namely aggregate processing plant, aggregate bagging plant, concrete batching plant, concrete block-making plant and buildings, ancillary offices and stores for processing and utilising aggregates landed at Newhaven Port and distribution of the products by road and rail together with access to the public highway and the extension of an existing rail siding.

**Comments:** I object to this development because it impinges on the only remaining public sandy shore (at low tide) now that the West beach is closed to the public. The access by road is not adequate and upgrading it is costly. The proposal for 24 hour use will allow noise at night and disturb peace even where I live, given the prevailing SW wind. The plant should go to other industrial land in Newhaven further inland which will allow better road connections.
