Dear Sir,

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Relating to land known as A259 Belle Hill, Bexhill on Sea to B2092 Queensway, St. Leonards on Sea, East Sussex RR/2474/CC(EIA) – Condition 11 (Out of Hours Working).

I am writing to request out of hours working for the weekends of 22nd/23rd February and 1st/2nd March between the following times:

- Saturday 13:00hrs – 17:00hrs; and
- Sunday 09:00hrs – 16:00hrs.

The works shall consist of Southern Water diversion no. 2, installation of dropped kerbs, removing the existing street markings and painting double yellow lines, all of which are indicated on the attached plan. As indicated the area will be on London Road between Salisbury Road and 20m on from Bancroft footpath.


The reason we cannot carry out this work during the week is because of a closure to Wrestwood Road. Throughout the works a route through London Road will still be possible.

The installation of dropped kerbs and application of the yellow lines will largely be a quiet operation, with noise limited to vehicles idling whilst lines are applied, and operatives talking. The removal of the existing markings will be noisier with the method of burning being employed.

This application is made on behalf of the Assistant Director – Transport and Operations, East Sussex County Council and the relevant cost code for payment of fees due is C.5.04.200.2.
