**Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Relating to land known as A259 Belle Hill,
Bexhill on Sea to B2092 Queensway, St. Leonards on Sea, East Sussex RR/2474/CC(EIA)
– Out of Hours Working.**

We are writing to request approval to carry out works in respect of the proposed Bexhill to Hastings Link Road development and hereby submit our application for approval.

The reason for the request is to mitigate the delays encountered from the adverse weather conditions experienced over the winter months. We wish to work the following hours outside of those stipulated under Planning Condition 11:

- Monday to Fridays 19:00hrs – 20:00hrs (from 18/05/2015 to week ending 14/08/2015);
- Saturdays 13:00hrs – 18:00hrs (from 16/05/2015 to week ending 08/08/2015); and
- Sundays 09:00hrs – 18:00hrs (from 17/05/2015 to week ending 09/08/2015).

We would like to highlight the point that we only intend to carry out works in the rural section (Ch.2000 – 5500) on Sundays. There will be no works carried out in the urban section of the scheme or the railway cutting on Sundays. Should we need to carry out essential works on a Sunday this will be subject to a separate application.

The locations and works we plan to carry out are as follows:

Urban Section:

- Gabion wall construction between Belle Hill and Ninfield Road; and
- Works on Ninfield Road Overbridge;

Rural Section:

- Cut and fill earthworks at Combe Haven, Actons Farm, Watermill, Hillcroft Farm, Powdermill, Adams Farm, Decoy Pond, Upper Wilting and Queensway;
- Drainage, fencing, safety barrier, kerbing, pavement, footpath, greenway, lighting, traffic signal and sign installation works;
- Gabion wall construction works;
- Works on the structures from SeaChange Roundabout to Queensway;
- Haul route maintenance from Elva Way to Crowhurst Road; and
- General plant maintenance in all areas between Elva Way to Crowhurst Road.

This application is made on behalf of the Assistant Director – Transport and Operations, East Sussex County Council and the relevant cost code for payment of fees due is C.5.04.200.2.

We trust that our proposals meet with your approval.
