## 1.0 Transport Statement

This transport statement should be read in conjunction with ermc ltd project drawing 2029-D-100 for the siting of a new single temporary mobile classroom at Whitehill Infant School, Luxford Road, Crowborough, East Sussex, TN6 2HW. As part of the planning application for the proposal, the below justification statement was provided;

For a number of years Whitehill Infant School has agreed to a classroom being used by the nursery setting which runs on site. This however has meant that the school does not have the capacity to increase its pupil member's long term without impacting on the numbers that the nursery can take. The implications of a new mobile in the first instance is to ensure that the nursery can retain the status quo on its numbers whilst allowing the school to take back the use of the classroom to accommodate the forecasted increase in pupil admission numbers. Long term this could mean an increase of 60 pupils and 2 staff.

In conclusion, whilst an increase in pupil numbers is forecasted, current admission documentation indicates that the majority of existing and prospective pupils live within Crowborough. That said, considering the concerns that the proposal will have an impact on the protected area of Ashdown Forest, the above confirms there will be no increase in traffic movements through this area thus there will be no additional impact.
