Thank you for your letter of 2 December regarding clarification. I hope this response and amendments to the submission will enable you to register the application.

1. Part 3 description has been amended.
2. Location and Block Plan now shows the access road marked from the public highway in orange and disabled bay added. Mr. Parker has informed me that he has no objection to a disabled bay alongside the access road as shown. He believes the area shaded in orange may still be retained by Network Rail, my attempts to verbally confirm this with their offices has brought no response to date.
