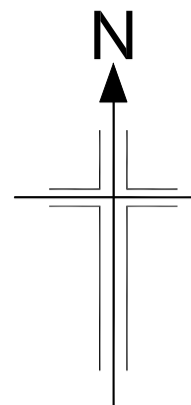
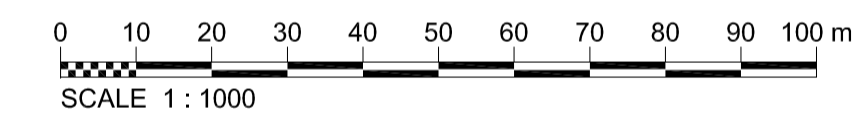

- High Forest - Dry (Planting at average 2m centres, random mix in groups of 3-5 of each species, not to be planted in obvious or straight lines) (LE2.1 and LE2.4.1)
  - High Forest - Dry (Planting at 2.5m centres, random mix in groups of 3-5 of each species, not to be planted in obvious or straight lines) (LE2.1 and LE2.4.1)
  - High Forest - Wet (Planting at average 2m centres, random mix in groups of 3-5 of each species, not to be planted in obvious or straight lines) (LE2.1 and LE2.4.1)
  - High Forest - Wet (Planting at average 2.5m centres, random mix in groups of 3-5 of each species, not to be planted in obvious or straight lines) (LE2.1 and LE2.4.1)
  - Woodland Edge planting at average 1.5m centres, random mix of 3-5 of each species. Care must be taken not to plant in obvious or straight lines (LE2.1 and LE2.4.1)
  - Scrub (Planting at average 1.5m spacing in a random mix in groups of 3-5 of each species, not to be planted in obvious or straight lines) (LE2.8)
  - Existing Woodland to be managed (LE2.1.1)
  - Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI)
  - Watercourse
  - Pond
  - Existing trees, hedges & scrub to be retained
