### EAST SUSSEX COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 The East Sussex (U6732 Rosinglams, Bexhill-on-Sea)

#### (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2009

To allow East Sussex Highways to carry out footway surfacing works, East Sussex County Council intend not less than seven days from the date of this notice to make an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following length of road:

**Temporary Road Closure**  
**U6732 Rosinglams, Bexhill-on-Sea** - from its junction with Primrose Hill for its entire length.

A safe route will be provided for pedestrians however, as this road is a cul-de-sac there is no diversion route available and access may be restricted during works.

The Order commences on 24 August 2009 and lasts for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated the road will only be closed for two days between 24 August 2009 and 3 September 2009.

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT) (ENGLAND AND WALES) REGULATIONS 1999 NOTICE UNDER REGULATION 21

I give notice that at their meeting on 10 December 2008 the Planning Committee of the Regulatory Committee of the County Council were minded to grant planning permission for the following development:

**RR2474(C)CE1(A) - Construction of new road, including environmental treatment with earthworks, planting flood and noise attenuation, wildlife compensation, and facilities for non-motorised users, A259 Belle Hill, Bexhill-on-Sea to B2929 Queensway, St Leonards-on-Sea.**

Following consideration by the Planning Committee the application was referred to the Secretary of State as being contrary to certain provisions of the Development Plan. On 3 February 2009 the Secretary of State confirmed that the Planning Application would not be 'called in' for her own determination. A legal undertaking has been signed by East Sussex County Council and planning permission was granted on 28 July 2009, subject to a number of conditions. The decision in respect of this application was taken following the consideration of environmental information contained in the Environmental Statement accompanying the planning application submitted by East Sussex County Council on 18 April 2007, the Environmental Statement Addendum submitted in August 2008 and the Supplementary Nature Conservation Report submitted in October 2008.

This statement sets out the main reasons and considerations on which the decision was based and a schedule of measures required to off-set any major adverse effects of the development. ### REGULATION ACT 1984 (Temporary Road Closure)
