Further to MPC's response to this application, done via your website last night – I'm attaching two photos showing the pump station compound and its impact on New Cut as attachments are not permitted via your website system.

New Cut is the main entrance to our Village, both from the A21 and Battle. It is a pleasant rural lane where our village sign (shortly to be re-erected) and noticeboard are located.

We have been assured verbally by Southern Water that **foliage screening will be planted inside the compound on the north elevation facing New Cut**, to screen as far as possible the impact of the compound from those using and living in New Cut – but this additional planting is not mentioned in the application.
