Dear Sir,

Town and Country Planning Act 1990 Relating to land known as A259 Belle Hill, Bexhill on Sea to B2092 Queensway, St. Leonards on Sea, East Sussex RR/2474/CC(EIA) – Out of Hours Working.

I am writing to request approval to carry out works in respect of the proposed Bexhill to Hastings Link Road development and hereby submit our application for approval.

At the request of ESCC, UKPN have agreed to work 12 hour shifts (7am - 7pm) 7 days a week in order to complete the Crowhurst Road over head line diversions. They will be working for a period of 8 weeks commencing on 17th June 2013 between Upper Wiling Farm and Swainham Lane under a road closure. The proposed diversion route is indicated in red on the enclosed UKPN plans.

UKPN's contractor (Compass) will have 2 gangs working from either end of the closure, they will be cutting the road (using a floor saw), trenching (using a mini excavator), laying duct and reinstating within Crowhurst Road.

UKPN have proposed to work these hours at the request of ESCC as delay to this diversion has major financial implications to the overall scheme.

This application is made on behalf of the Assistant Director – Economy, East Sussex County Council and the relevant cost code for payment of fees due is C.5.04.200.2.

We trust that our proposals meeting with your approval.
